The paper will be assigned to a friendly reviewer who gives feedback on the paper. The paper will be presented before the general plenum. Extended abstracts will be discussed in the form of interactive discussion sessions.
Format of extended abstracts	Extended abstract should have max. 1,000 words and include topic, method, findings & contributions.
Format of papers	Papers should be in English and between 6,000 and 10,000 words in length. Each paper must include an abstract. As the papers are distributed electronically there is no style guide to observe. <i>Please also</i> include your full name, title, function, and institution.
