Double Degree with HEC Paris

- **Target group:** Master students in Management & Technology (MMT)
- **Study Procedure:** 1st and 2nd semester at TUM, 3rd & 4th semester at HEC, 5th semester TUM / HEC (Master's Thesis)
- **Duration of stay abroad:** 2 semesters plus internship (15 weeks)
- **Cost:** Administrative fee of about €950 per academic year
- **Awarded degrees:** "Master of Science" by TUM & "Master in Management - Grande École degree" by HEC Paris plus certificate, possibly scholarship by Deutsch-Französische Hochschule (DFH)
- **Language skills:** English (C1), French (B2), German (B2)

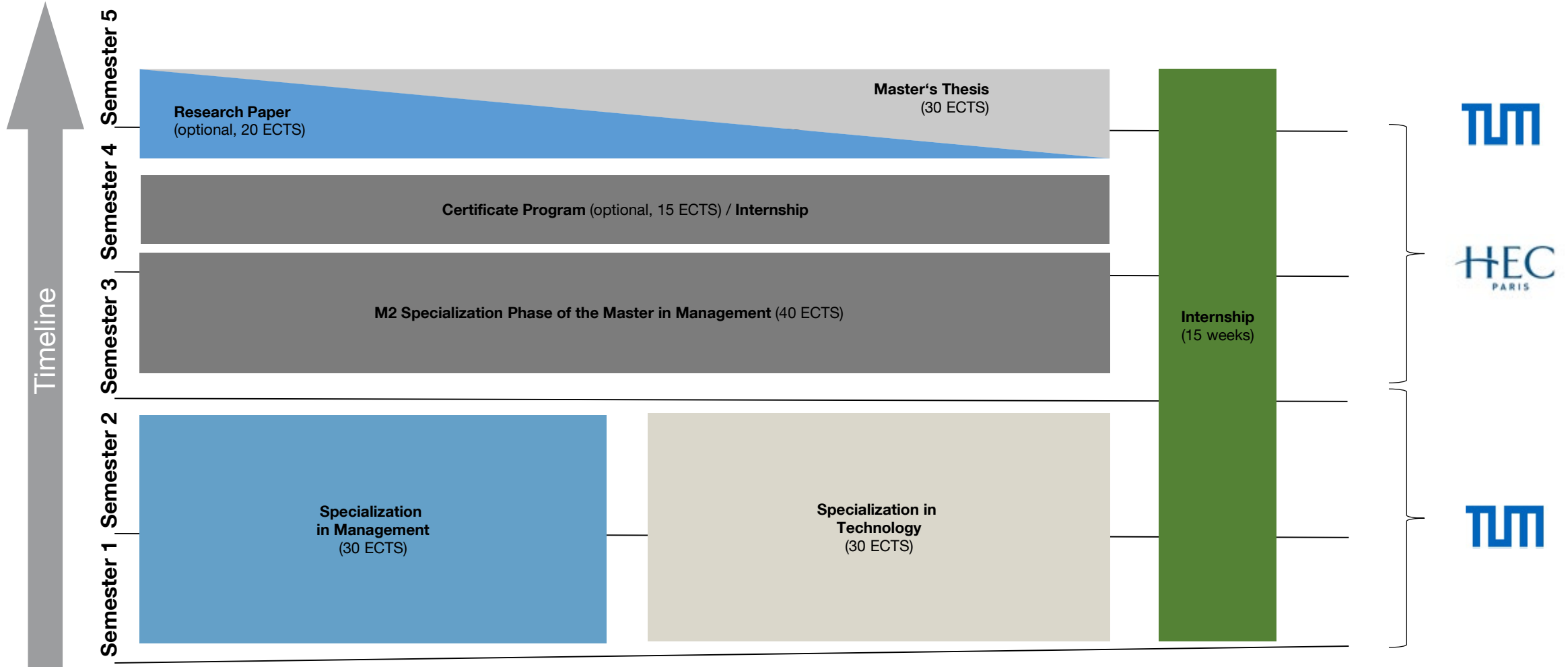

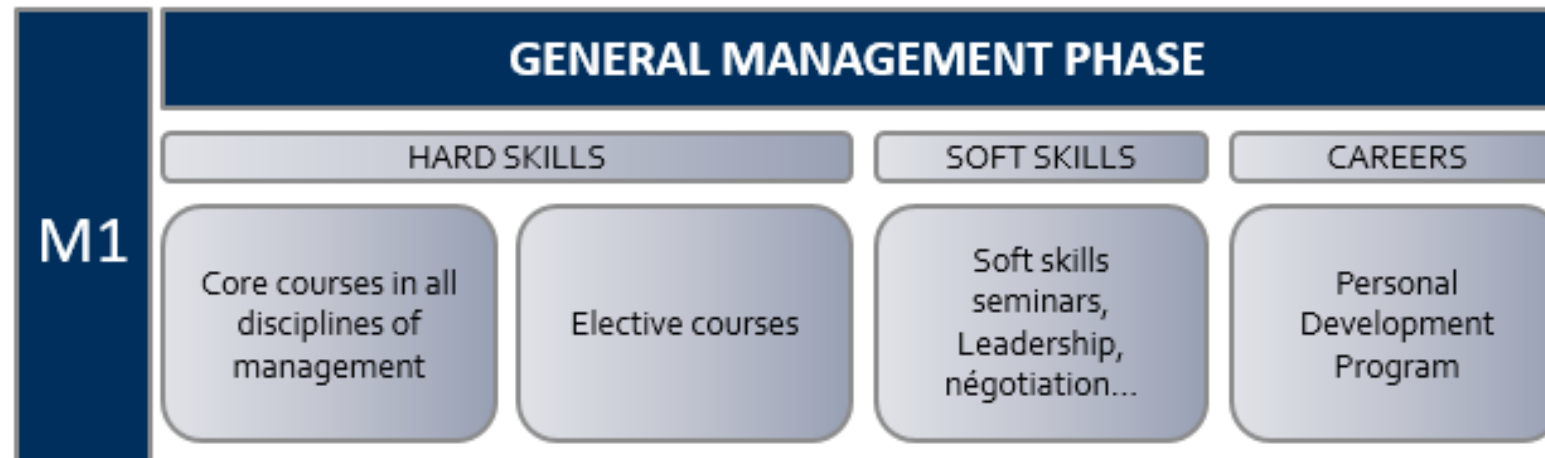

The University of Texas at Austin

Scope: STEP program will let graduate students from TUM and UT to expand their knowledge and understanding of the *opportunities and challenges of the energy transition and decarbonisation* with:

- TUM School of Management Master's students will get the opportunity to spend 1 semester at the University of Texas at Austin and take courses on climatology, engineering, resources economics, and more, joining the Energy and Earth Resources Graduate Program.
- Working on their Master's Thesis with the main supervisor at TUM Center for Energy Markets, students will get a unique opportunity to enrich their work and expertise collaborating with UT researchers.



 **TEXAS** STEP: Sustainable Transitions Exchange Program
The University of Texas at Austin

- **Target group:** Master's programs across all campuses (MMT, MIM, MCS, MSMT) **with interest in energy transition, sustainability**
- **Study program:** 2nd or 3rd semester of the TUM School of Management Master's program (extension of your Master's Program possible!)
- **Duration of stay abroad:** 1 semester from early August until Mid-December (4th or 5th semester)
- **Expected final qualification:** "Master of Science" at TUM and an official STEP certificate and a Transcript of Records from the UT Austin

TEXAS STEP: Sustainable Transitions Exchange Program

The University of Texas at Austin

Application Documents:

- Bachelor's Degree incl. Transcript of Records
- Current TUM Transcript of Records (average grade better than 2.2) with at least 30 ECTS
- List of current courses attending at TUM School of Management course
- DAAD Language Certificate English (C1 or higher) or equivalent test (TOEFL, IELTS,...) (not for native speaker English => proof is needed)
- Letter of motivation in English (max. 1 ½ pages)
- CV
- Matriculation certificate

Application Procedure is a two-step process:

1. Preselection according to application documents
2. Interview

Costs: no fees, but costs of living:
Journey to and from US (Texas): 600 – 1,000 euros
Personal and living expenses (incl. accommodation and food): 1,000 – 2,000 euros per month
Health insurance (Enrollment in the UT Austin insurance plan is mandatory): 1,300 euros per semester (subject to change)
Additional costs for Visa and individual plans

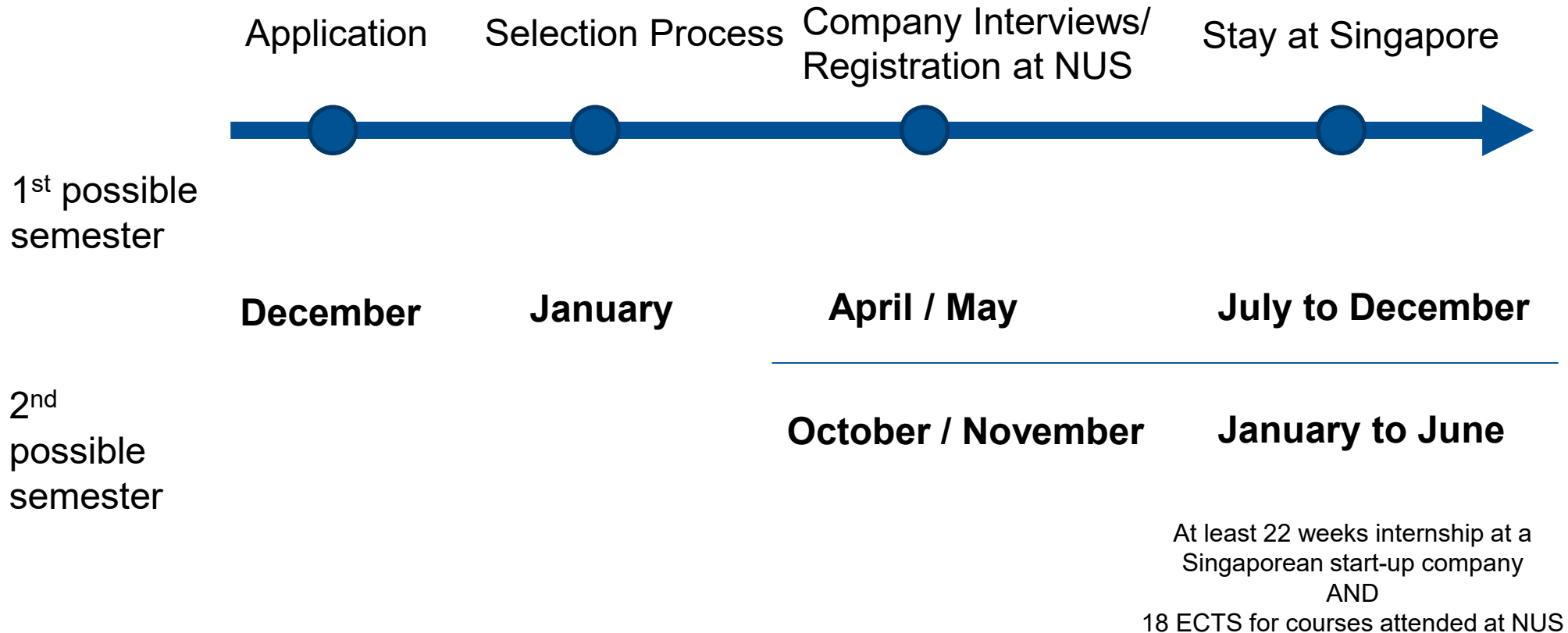

Entrepreneurship Exchange Program with NUS

- **Target group:** TUM School of Management undergraduate and graduate students with interest in “Innovation and Entrepreneurship”
- **Number of places:** 15 per year
- **Length of stay:** at least 22 weeks internship (July – Dec 2024 OR Jan – Jun 2025)
- **Expected final qualification:** official EEP certificate, transcript of records from NUS, a reference from a Singaporean start-up company
- **Language skills:** English C1 DAAD or equivalent
- **Application Semester:** B.Sc. students can apply at least in their 3rd semester
M.Sc. students in their 1st / 2nd semester



Entrepreneurship Exchange Program with NUS

Application Documents:

- Current transcript of records AND for graduate students: Bachelor Degree + Abitur / Baccalaureate / A level certificate
- CV including personal statement, qualifications and other skills (use NUS template available from factsheet)
- DAAD Language Test English or equivalent (C1)
- Matriculation Certificate

Costs:

- Journey to and from Singapore: 800–1,500 euros
- Personal and living expenses (incl. accommodation and food): 1,000 -1,500 euros per month (option to live on NUS campus)
- Additional costs for individual plans
- Financial support to the intern is not guaranteed and depends on the start-up.

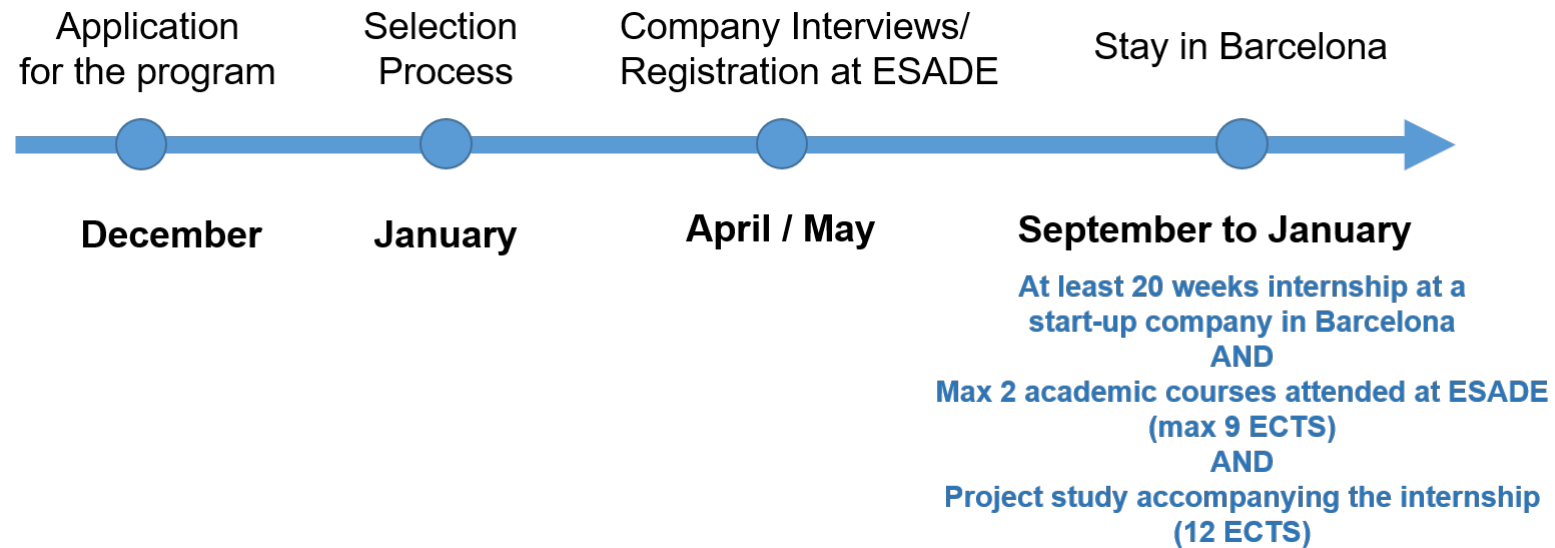

- **Target group:** TUM School of Management undergraduate students with interest in “Innovation and Entrepreneurship”
- **Number of places:** 5 per year
- **Length of stay:** at least **20 weeks** internship (Sep-Jan)
- **Expected final qualification:** official EEP certificate, transcript of records from ESADE, a reference from a Spanish start-up company
- **Language skills:** English C1 DAAD or equivalent; Spanish basic knowledge is recommended
- **Application Semester:** B.Sc. students can apply at least in their 3rd semester

- Current transcript of records AND for graduate students: Bachelor Degree + Abitur/Baccalaureate/A level certificate
- CV including personal statement, qualifications and other skills
- DAAD Language Test English or equivalent (C1), language proficiency Spanish (if possible)

- Journey to and from Barcelona
- Personal and living expenses (incl. accommodation and food)
- Additional costs for individual plans
- Financial support to the intern is not guaranteed and depends on the start-up
- Application for funding through Erasmus possible

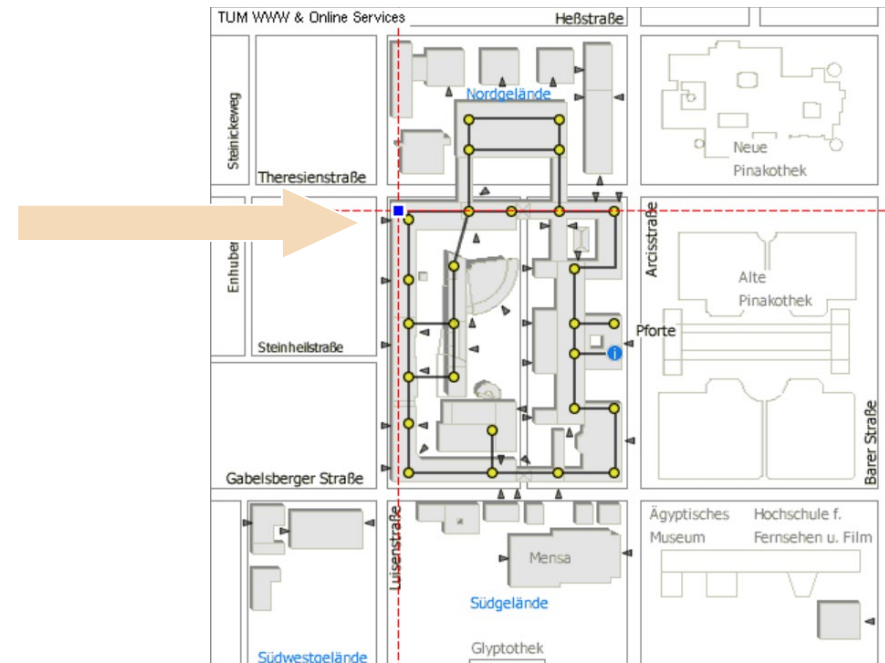
