Program facts

- network of more than 20 academic partners and 15 corporate partners worldwide
- **Target group:** Master students in MMT with an interest in quantitative education
- **Program structure:**
 - 1st + 2nd semester at TUM
 - 3rd + 4th semester 1 exchange semester at an academic QTEM partner, [Global Business Analytics Challenge](#) (GBAC), internship of at least 6-8 weeks (240 working hours);
 - 4th/5th semester Master's Thesis
- **Study plan:** during the MMT studies min. 45 ECTS in quantitative courses
- **Duration of stay abroad:** maximum 1 year (3rd and 4th semester) in two different countries for study and optional internship abroad (2nd study abroad is possible but not recommended)
- Successful QTEM Students are earning a certificate from the  **Masters Network** together with the “**Master of Science**” degree from TUM.

The ideal MMT program including the QTEM network



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

	2. Application via e-mail to qtem@mgt.tum.de	
 personal interview	Pre-selection based on the submitted documents	before Christmas
	Interviews take place	January / beginning of February
 TUM SOMex	Additional application for the exchange program TUM SOMex is possible	
	In the case of successful nomination for JIP the application for TUM SOMex is automatically annulled	

Required Documents for your application

- Bachelor Degree **OR**
- Current Transcript of Records (for students from the Bachelor's program in Management and Technology in their last Bachelor's semester)
- 5 preferences from QTEM Partner Universities (specified in "application registration" link)
- A list of courses and results with quantitative contents taken at TUM School of Management (min 30 ECTS) **OR**
- **GMAT (or GRE) 650 and higher** (taken within the last 3 years)
- **GMAT Focus Edition 595 or higher**
- Abitur / Baccalaureate / A level certificate
- DAAD Language Test English (C1 or higher) or equivalent
- Letter of motivation in English (max. 1½ pages)
- CV
- Matriculation certificate

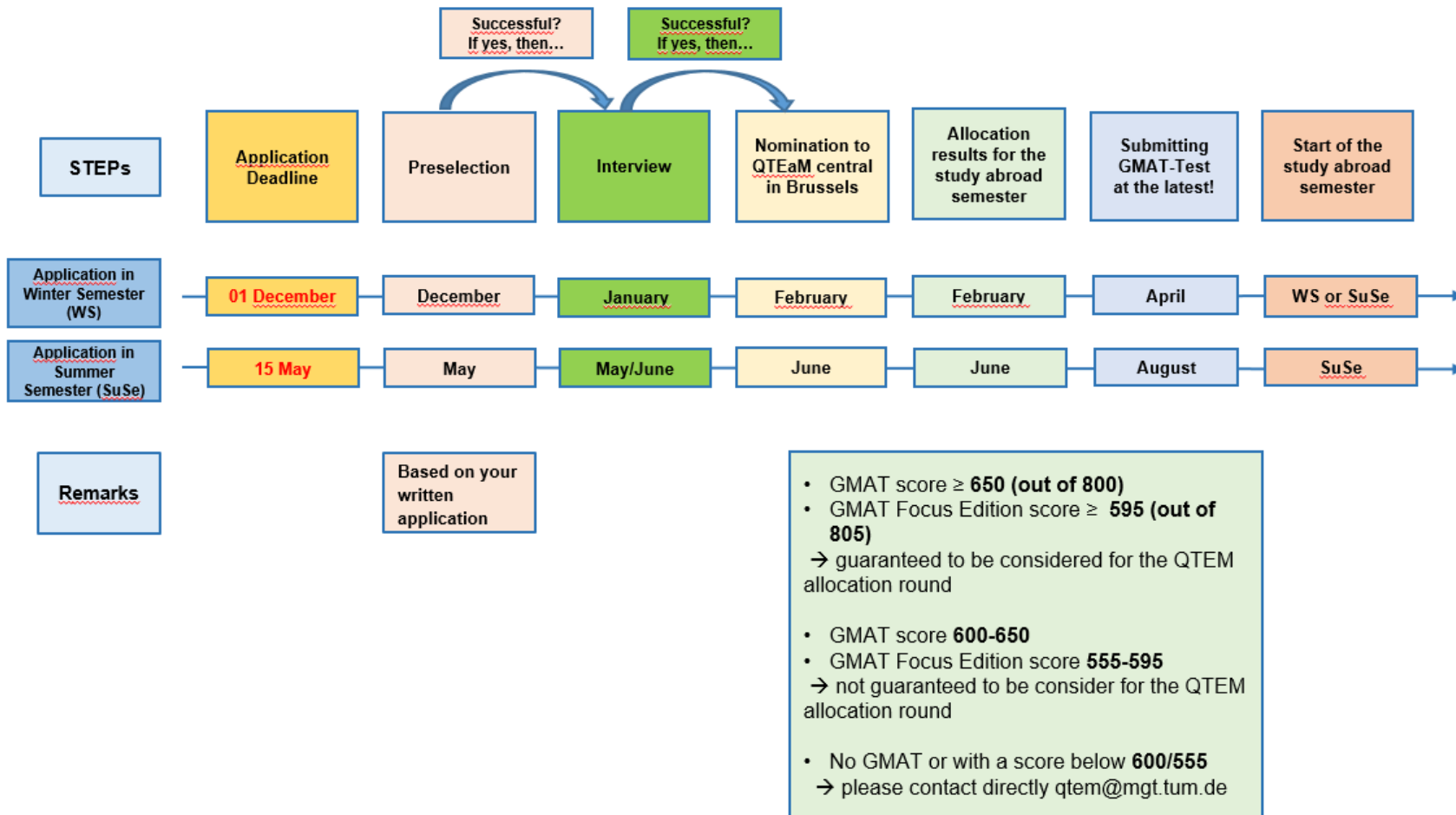

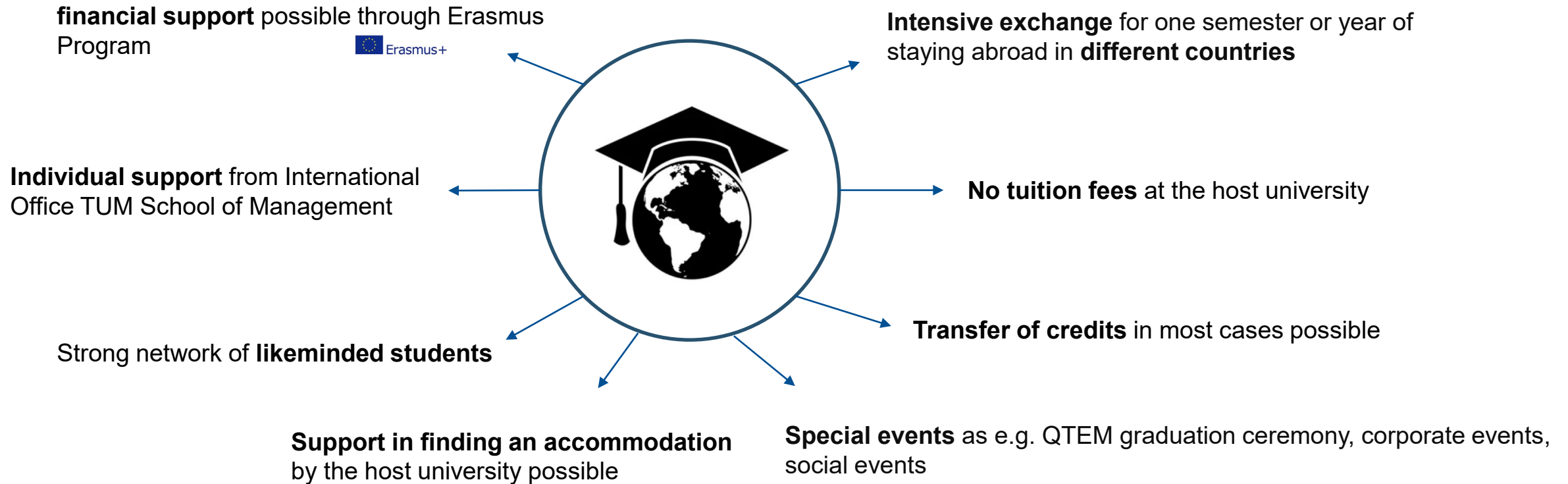
Selection Procedure: timeline

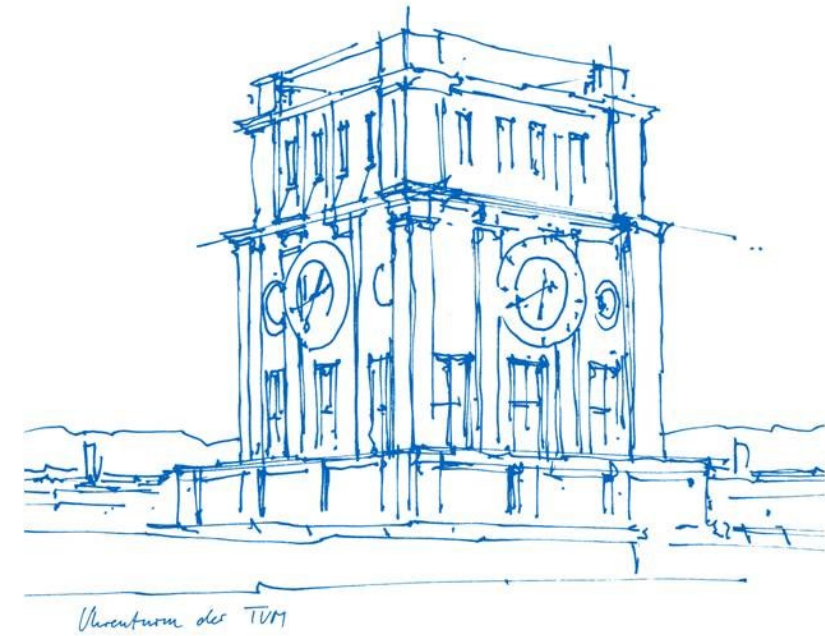
